

Downloading SCORM Packages from Brainshark

Sharable Content Object Reference Model (SCORM) is a collection of standards and specifications for web-based e-learning. It defines communications between client side content and a Learning Management System (LMS). The communication between these systems is helpful if you want to use Brainshark to produce SCORM-compliant eLearning courses that can be deployed through your LMS, with full compatibility for completion criteria and progress assessment.

Brainshark makes it easy to integrate presentations with your existing LMS by offering a SCORM download option. If your LMS does not support SCORM, or is AICC compliant, please contact [Brainshark Support](#) for assistance.

SCORM Download Options Available in Brainshark

Regardless of the SCORM download package you select, there will be a real-time connection from your LMS to your content in Brainshark so that any updates made to the presentation will be reflected in your learning management system (LMS) without having to download a new SCORM package. Both the Basic and Enhanced packages are available as SCORM 1.2 and SCORM 2004.

Consult the documentation provided by your LMS Vendor to determine whether your LMS supports SCORM 2004, which is the current version, or SCORM 1.2, an older but still widely used version. For additional assistance, please contact [Brainshark Support](#).

- **Basic Packages**—these packages will provide a Student status and score will be shared with the LMS.
- **Enhanced Packages**—in addition to updates sent in the Basic package, the Enhanced package will also share questions and responses. **NOTE:** The enhanced packages require that *.brainshark.com be a trusted Internet site.

How to Download a SCORM Package

1. Navigate to **Edit Presentation**.
2. On the *Things you can do* menu, select **Download SCORM**.
3. Select the package you would like to download and click **Download**.
4. When the page refreshes, select **Click here**.
5. Click **Save** and select a location to save the Zip file.
