

Brainshark Viewing History

Available in the Brainshark Viewing Console, your Personal Viewing History will help you easily access Brainshark and myBrainshark presentations you've viewed in the past.


Possibilities

All Brainshark customers have the option of restricting access on the Personal Viewing History to only their presentations. So if you are viewing a Brainshark presentation from a customer that has restricted access and you click the Personal Viewing History icon, you will only see Brainshark presentations that you have viewed in the past from that particular customer.

All Brainshark customers also have the option of turning off the Personal Viewing History in the Brainshark Viewing Console. So if you are viewing a Brainshark presentation from a customer that has disabled the Personal Viewing History, the Personal Viewing History icon will not appear in the Viewing Console.

How Do You Access Your Viewing History?

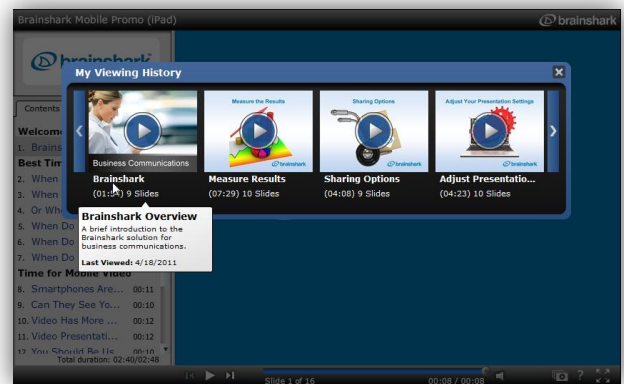
Viewing History is available in the Brainshark Viewing Console.

1. Click the Viewing History icon,  in the lower right corner of the Brainshark Viewing Console to open the Viewing History tiles.
2. If you do not see a Viewing History icon, it is likely because the company whose Brainshark you are viewing, has disabled the feature.

What Will You See?

Once you open the Viewing History, you'll see the presentations you have viewed in the past displayed onscreen as tiles, 4 at a time.

1. Use the arrows to navigate through the list.
2. Hover over the thumbnail title to see the description of the presentation.
3. Click a presentation thumbnail to begin viewing that presentation. The presentation will load into the current browser window.
