Brainshark Training

Author Search

- Learning authors can search for any title they have created without opening the Course Catalog by searching on the My Course/My Curriculums pages.

Enrollment Search

- Learning authors can search for students and groups they wish to enroll in a course or curriculum by searching in the Enrolled Students page.

Open Enrollment Maximum

- Learning authors can restrict the number of students who can enroll themselves in a course. Cadmins can enable this functionality from Manage Settings page. Auto-enrollments will ignore this setting.

Brainshark Coaching

Reviewer Submission Usability Enhancement

- Challenge Reviewers have an additional option for submitting a review within the rating area. The submission confirmation has been visually improved.

Brainshark Content

HTML5 Player Video Quality Control

- With this release of the HTML5 player, video streaming quality has been improved, and the highest possible resolution will be dynamically set based on available bandwidth. Users may directly adjust the video streaming quality through player settings.
- The following are known limitations with the Video Quality Control
 - a. This feature is only available when streaming video content, and does not apply when playing mixed content.
 - b. Mobile browsers on iOS are not supported.
 - c. Internet Explorer on Windows 7 is not supported.

FIXED

- SA 4.15 problem launching Brainshark Training from mobile Salesforce1
- Poor video performance on HTML5 player with video freezing
