### Sales Accelerator 4.15

#### Support for “Lightning Ready” Certification

Sales Accelerator is fully functional in Salesforce Lightning Experience and adopts Lightning styling. Customers can install one Sales Accelerator package, regardless of whether they use Salesforce Classic or Lightning Experience.

UPDATE (Feb. 22, 2017): Sales Accelerator 4.15.1 is now available and has officially received “Lightning Ready” certification from Salesforce. This update does not contain new features.

#### Improved Content Search/Favorites Tab

In this release, the user-selected view of the Search/Favorites tab persists, and this overrides the system default view of the Search/Favorites tab. After selecting a view in one Salesforce record and navigating to another record or object, or logging out and logging back into Salesforce, the user will see the most recently selected view of the Search/Favorites tab. The system default view of the Search/Favorites tab remains Most Recently Sent.

#### New Learning Launcher Tab for Salesforce

Sales Accelerator includes a new Learning Launcher VisualForce page and VisualForce tab. The tab can be placed on the Chatter profile page, and replaces the previous Brainshark Learning for Chatter functionality.

## FIXED

The following issues were fixed in Sales Accelerator:

- Exception Error “'StaticResource' is not supported” during Sales Accelerator upgrade
- ‘Additional To:’ email functionality not responsive in an IOS browser
- Presentations unable to be shared from Salesforce1

The following issues were fixed in Brainshark:

- Non-enrolled users appearing in Curriculum Summary reports
- Mobile version not being generated properly for long presentations

UPDATE (January 4, 2017): The following issues were fixed in Brainshark:

- Internal views in Salesforce not syncing properly
- Podcast audio not playing correctly for presentations with wrapped slides
- “Check all” checkbox not working in pop-up used by admins to add new course enrollments for users
- Errors when launching Learning content in Salesforce1
